NON-NEGOTIABLE ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR THE CRET BURSARY

<u>Applicants must satisfy the following minimum entry criteria before applying</u>. (Failure to meet all requirements will lead to your application not being considered):

- Only South African citizens between the ages of 16 and 27 years, with a demonstrable financial need (household income below R650K per annum).
- Current matriculants and/or undergraduate students already enrolled at a recognised South African learning institution.
- All applicants will need to provide a strong motivation for their application.
- Consideration will only be made for those who have applied or registered for study in the following undergraduate fields:
 - 1. Sciences (excluding MBChB)
 - 2. Technology
 - 3. Engineering
 - 4. Commerce and Finance
 - 5. Education
 - 6. Scarce/critical skills training (such as boiler making, welding, plumbing, OHS, renewable energy, waste management, green technology, entrepreneurship, etc.)

SHORTLISTED CANDIDATES will be required to provide the following Compulsory Documentation, on request:

- SA ID Document (certified copy)
- **Proof of family household income below R650k per annum** (latest pay slips if employed, affidavit if unemployed, proof of pension or grant if applicable)
- Proof of home address
- Academic record (most recent certified copy)
- Proof of acceptance letter from the learning institution
- Motivational Letter
- Psychometric Test

ABOUT THE CRET BURSARY

- The bursary will provide cover for tuition fees, textbooks and other study materials, accommodation, meals, a monthly living allowance, and transport, where required.
- Before the final selection of 2025 beneficiaries is made, shortlisted candidates will be required to participate in a formal assessment process, which may include a formal interview.
